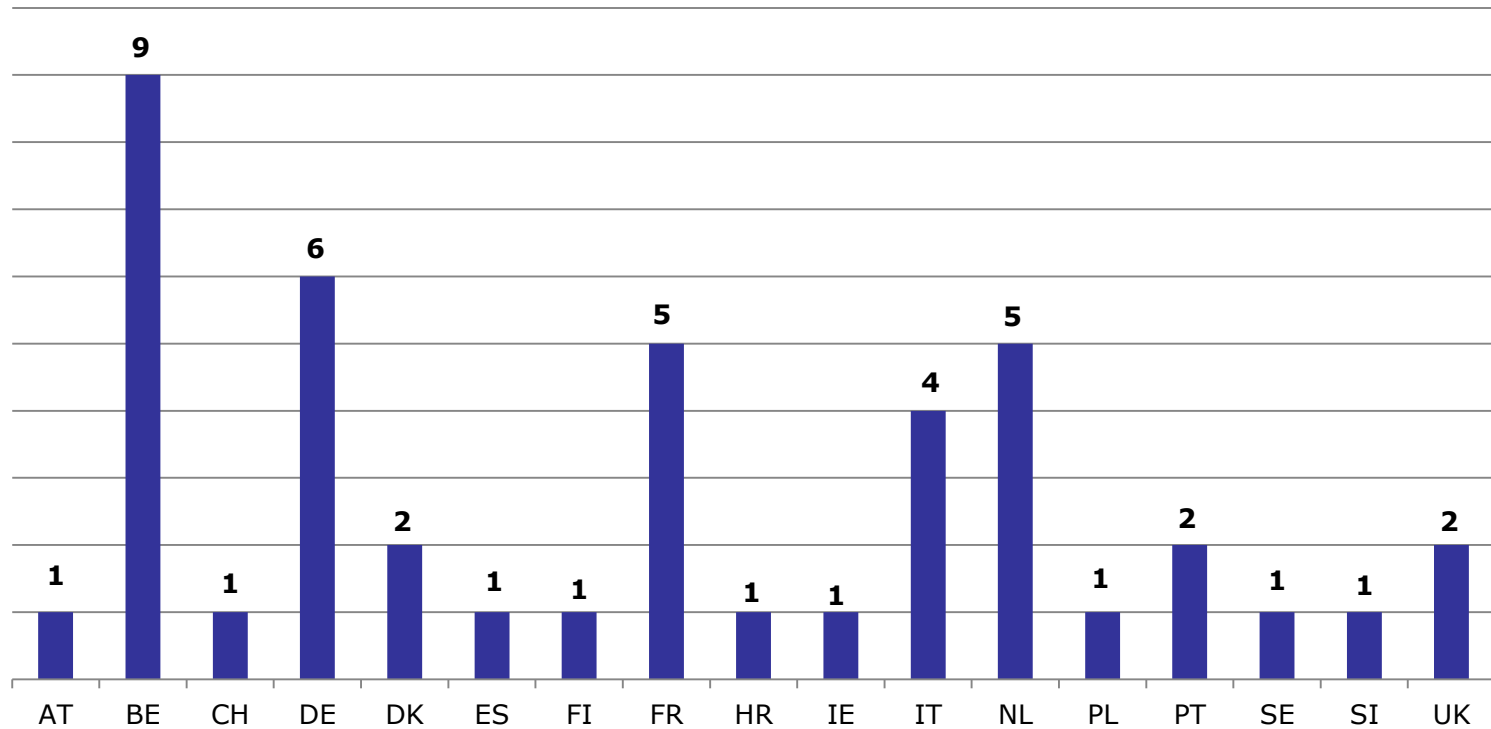
General remarks

- **Low participation for subtopic (ii) and (iii)***
- **Good quality with 4 proposals at/or above threshold (12/15).**
- **All four interoperability subtopics will be funded:**
 - (i) Standardization
 - (ii) ePrescription
 - (iii) SNOMED
 - (iv) CEF

Remarks on short list

- **The retained proposals cover all areas listed in the Work Programme topic PHC 34. The retained proposals are:**
 - eStandards (Standardization): Common reference information model for eHealth deployment
 - openMedicine (ePrescriptions): Common data model/vocabulary for medicinal or pharmaceutical products
 - ASSESS_CT (SNOMED): Detailed analysis on the advantages and disadvantages, as well as the impact of using SNOMED CT as the core terminology at the EU level
 - VALUEHEALTH (CEF): Identification of right business models and plans which would determine sustainable sources of revenue and related costs
